

Long-term storage

When ordering the packaged goods from AruTech Parimad Aknad, we can offer different packaging methods for the safe transportation of the goods to the installation site.

Please note that the packaging is intended only for transportation and is not meant for long-term storage.

When receiving the goods, please follow the rules below:

1. Plastic windows should be transported vertically at an angle of no more than 15°.
2. Ready-made windows should be stored indoors at the temperature not lower than 5°C, avoid direct sunlight falling on the windows. At the temperature above +25°C, when the windows are stored under the packaging film, a thermal shock may occur which may lead to the breaking of the glazed unit of the product or deformation of its profiles and glass slats.
3. Unpack the goods (remove the packaging film from the pallet, remove the packing tape) and review the goods immediately within 3 days after receiving the goods, and in case of external damage, send us the APPENDIX 1 of the contract and a photo of the position number of the item. The claims for external damage to the goods will not be accepted later.
4. The protective film covering the profiles should be removed within 20 days after receiving the goods. If kept for a longer time, it may be difficult or impossible to remove it from the frame or its structure.
5. Store the goods in such a way as to avoid tension in them (vertically as far as possible, taking into account the mutual compatibility of the dimensions of the goods). Otherwise, the goods may be deformed in case of long-term tension.
6. If the windows are stored in the open air, moisture can get into the windows. When storing ready-made windows on the construction site, dust and dirt can get into the windows, which can damage the window surface and internal mechanisms.
7. In case of violation of the rules of transport, storage and operation, the guarantee does not apply to the goods.
